A reception for the artist will be held from 5 to 7 PM on Friday, January 13, 2023. It will be part of the Noyes Arts Garage's Second Friday event.

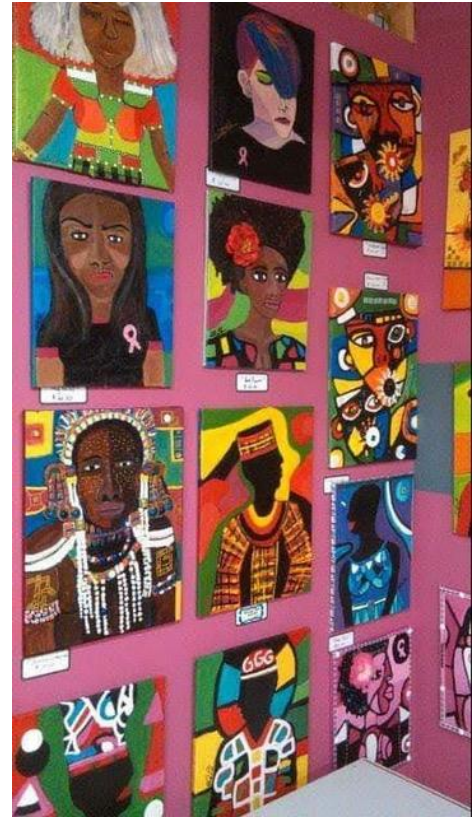
