Anthony Johnson is a self-taught visual artist who was born and raised in Atlantic City, New Jersey. As an emerging artist, his catalog of work covers only the last five years. Currently residing in Collingswood, New Jersey, he balances raising his three children with creating his paintings.

Johnson states that his “paintings reflect and use neo-expressionism, real life references and, most of all, ... memories created through life experiences.” His paintings incorporate a wide array of mediums including oil, acrylic, spray paint, and pastels. They are usually finished with a coat of varnish or resin.

He has exhibited his work in exhibitions across the tri-state area including Collingswood, NJ; TriBeCa and the Bronx in New York City; Pennsauken, NJ; and now Atlantic City, NJ. Most notably, Johnson participated in Armory Art Week in TriBeCa, and The Bronx Brewery Art Expo in the Bronx.
